**NICENE CREED**

**We believe in one God**, the Father, the Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all that is, seen and unseen.

**We believe in one leader with authority, Jesus Christ**, the only Son of God, eternally established by the Father, God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, established, not made, of one Being with the Father; through him all things were made. For us and to save us, he came down from heaven, was embodied by the Holy Spirit and the virgin Mary becoming truly human. For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate; he suffered death and was buried. On the third day he rose again in accordance with the Scriptures; he went up into heaven and sits at the right hand of God the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead, and his kingdom will have no end.

**We believe in the Holy Spirit**, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son is worshiped and glorified, who has spoken through the prophets. We believe in one holy universal body of Christian believers acknowledging the leading of the apostles of Jesus. We acknowledge one baptism for the forgiveness of sins. We look for the resurrection of the dead, and the life of the world to come.

On this we agree!

<b>Who leads this work?</b>	<b>We acknowledge Jesus as our leader</b> and God, Jesus' Father, as the one God supremely worthy of our full worship. We acknowledge Holy Spirit as the one through whom God's work is done daily by those who affirm and believe this by following the guidelines provided in the Holy Bible.
<b>What is our fundamental statement of faith?</b>	The contents of the <b>Christian bible!</b> However we summarise our beliefs using the <u>Nicene creed</u> , a contemporary copy of which is found below.
<b>Who can attend?</b>	<b>Anyone</b> who has internet access or can get to Ken and Penny's home. <u>See location</u> . Currently located in Kearney, Ontario, Canada, for those who want to attend in person.
<b>Where is the primary Celebration location?</b>	In the <b>homes of believers</b> who attend, currently in Kearney, and on the internet via the SGC Celebrate website conferencing and meeting tools.
<b>Why do we get together?</b>	<b>Celebration of the risen Christ with likeminded people who want to do something constructive</b> each week as a result of their faith and want to serve their community with the power inherent in a Holy Spirit led group, who want to have fun, learn more about being an active Christian and just enjoying life as a Christian among friends!
<b>What makes us different?</b>	<b>We care and we show it with demonstrated actions</b> within our community. We plan to have fun together!
<b>When do we get together?</b>	Currently <b>we plan to get together Sundays from 3pm to 5pm for our celebration</b> . Work parties and other get together to serve the community could take precedent over this occasionally. There will also be <b>activities on other days of the week</b> , meeting our communities' needs in small ways as God makes us available. We do intend to have a <b>mid-week bible study</b> via the internet as well.
