Angry thoughts swirl through the mind. Rage churns up explosively and retribution seems to be the only true outcome.

The movies show us scene after scene where an insulted, hurt or mistreated person finds a way to turn the tables on the opponent and retribution results.



The sad thing is that many people see this as a right way through circumstances of this type. Where does it lead?

Think of it! Have we ever fallen into this trap in the past? I know I have!

As a majority shareholder and CEO in a company I started, two other partners who were out to take some money from some employees that we needed to let go wanted me to go along with it.

I wouldn't do it and that resulted in me being fired from my own company!

Anger reigned supreme for many days!
How would you have felt in similar circumstances?
I lost millions of \$'s and then they wanted \$500k of my personal loan money that was supporting the company.
They said that they needed it.

What did I do?



I went to an attorney and he said he could sue them for everything they owned.

That's when my Christian values kicked in! I remembered Romans 12:17 where it says:

Do not repay anyone evil for evil. Be careful to do what is right in the eyes of everyone. If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone. Do not take revenge, my dear friends, but leave room for God's wrath, for it is written: "It is mine to avenge; I will repay," says the Lord. [NIV]

I met the *mean trial attorney* and heard his words. I realised what he would do.

The words from our bible emerged in my thoughts as I absorbed those law office events.

Do not repay anyone evil for evil. Be careful to do what is right in the eyes of everyone. If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone. Do not take revenge, my dear friends, but leave room for God's wrath, for it is written: "It is mine to avenge; I will repay," says the Lord. [NIV]

Those bible words are for the courageous!

My partners were not Christian as far as I knew. I knew their wives and children. I knew that to take my money out that company would mean employees would suffer.

I knew suing them would generate more horror mindsets in my own head.

Basically, I knew God was right! BUT...I really didn't want to know this at that time!

Forgiveness made sense in the global view where I didn't place myself at the center of the universe. I knew God was right, even though it meant I would loose more!

That's how we gain perspective and follow
That's how we gain perspect. That's how we
God's wisdom in this respect. That's how we
can avoid replaying evil for evil! That's how pain
become better people and avoid long term pain
become better people and avoid long.

Remember God's truths!



Satan wanted me handcuffed to horrible revengeful thoughts! Instead compassion and love for others welled up and I gave up the money, the prestige, the control to others who I knew were evil.

There was a wonderful good man among my partners.

Not Christian but a Jew. He was my closest friend and since we did believed in the same God (from different perspectives) he had similar values to myself.

God used him to protect those who were in the company from the wrong that could have happened.

The fear of the court case that never came stopped the evil men from doing further evil.

Good resulted!

David and Saul

- 1 Samuel 16:1
 - [Samuel Anoints David to Be Israel's King] The Lord said to Samuel, "How long will you be filled with sorrow because of Saul? I have refused to have him as king over Israel. Fill your animal horn with olive oil and go on your way. I am sending you to Jesse in Bethlehem. I have chosen one of his sons to be king."
- 1 Samuel 16:14
 - [David Serves Saul] The Spirit of the Lord had left Saul. And an evil spirit that was sent by the Lord terrified him.
- 1 Samuel 16:19
 - Then Saul sent messengers to Jesse. He said, "Send me your son David, the one who takes care of your sheep."
- 1 Samuel 16:22
 - Saul sent a message to Jesse. It said, "Let David stay here. I want him to serve me. I'm pleased with him."
- 1 Samuel 16:23
 - When the evil spirit that was sent by God would come on Saul, David would get his harp and play it. That would help Saul. He would feel better, and the evil spirit would leave him.

David and Saul

- 1 Samuel 18:1
 - Saul Becomes Jealous of David | David finished talking with Saul. After that, Jonathan and David became close friends. Jonathan loved David just as he loved himself.
- 1 Samuel 18:9-11
 - From that time on, Saul became very jealous of David. So he watched him closely. The next day an evil spirit that was sent by God came on Saul with power. Saul began to prophesy in his house. At that same time David began to play the harp, just as he usually did. Saul was holding a spear. He threw it at David. As he did, he said to himself, "I'll pin David to the wall." But David got away from him twice.
- 1 Samuel 23:7
 - Saul Chases David] Saul was told that David had gone to Keilah. He said, "God has handed him over to me. David has trapped himself by entering a town that has gates and heavy metal bars."

David and Saul

- 1 Samuel 24:4
 - David's men said, "This is the day the Lord told you about.
 He said to you, 'I will hand your enemy over to you. Then
 you can deal with him as you want to.' "So David came up
 close to Saul without being seen. He cut off a corner of
 Saul's robe.
- 1 Samuel 24:5
 - Later, David felt sorry that he had cut off a corner of Saul's robe.
- 1 Samuel 26:12
 - So David took the spear and water jug that were near Saul's head. Then he and Abishai left. No one saw them. No one knew about what they had done. In fact, no one even woke up. Everyone was sleeping.


Think of the person you have the most anger against in life.

Nicene Creed

- We believe in one God, the Father, the Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all that is, seen and unseen.
