


Wisdom & words


A university student lost his voice for a few days when I was a student.

How it impacted him!

Days later when his voice returned, he
was choosing his words far more carefully
and let us all know he had found out that
we waste and abuse words terribly! The
sincerity and concentrated emotion that
came with those words of his, has had me
remembering them for over thirty years!

How little we consider the privilege we have in communicating by speaking and hearing!





Then we open our mouths and our vocal chords dance in carefully controlled vibrations, modified by an acrobatic tongue and lips,


to form sounds that have **immense** power.

Not in their sound, but rather in their meaning!



WORDS reveal a persons WISDOM don't they? If we have ever watched a baby learning to speak, we know that they understand before they speak.

Words follow the creation of meaning and are an attempt to reveal the inward constructions of our minds activity.



"WISDOM IS NOT A PRODUCT OF **SCHOOLING BUT OF THE LIFELONG** ATTEMPT TO **ACQUIRE IT"** ~ Albert Einstein

Fine for Albert to say as he was one of the smartest people that ever lived . . .

...but it is interesting that he says wisdom is not gained by schooling

So many of us think if we can get that next degree or be able to achieve that next academic award, or write that thesis or rub shoulders with the academic elite we will be wiser. Albert says that's not how you get it!

Wisdom is deeper! Even the online dictionary[1] says this in its definition

wis-dom (w z d m)

n.

- The ability to discern or judge what is true, right, or lasting; insight.
- 2. Common sense; good judgment: "It is a characteristic of wisdom not to do desperate things" (Henry David Thoreau).

3.

- a. The sum of learning through the ages; knowledge: "In those homely sayings was couched the collective wisdom of generations" (Maya Angelou).
- b. Wise teachings of the ancient sages.
- 4. A wise outlook, plan, or course of action.
- Wisdom Bible Wisdom of Solomon.

So if we cannot get wise by learning stuff and common sense is something that has to be gained and cannot be learned, are we lost?

How do we go about getting wisdom?

The bible says this:

Proverbs 1:5-7 (NIV)

- 5 let the wise listen and add to their learning, and let the discerning get guidance— 6 for understanding proverbs and parables, the sayings and riddles of the wise.
- 7 The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge, but fools despise wisdom and instruction.

Note that a fool in this context refers to a morally deficient person.

It says fear of God is the beginning of wisdom. This is the start point.

So those academics who do not fear God are not wise as they have not yet reached the starting point of wisdom.

We have to come to grips with the fact that God is before all things, created all things and sustains all things.

Respect for God is the start of wisdom.

Note, I didn't say accepting God as a personal saviour (our modern war cry that is overused and become a platitude) since that is NOT what the bible says.

All it says is fear of God is central to starting to get wisdom.

Fear grows from respect and understanding consequences, doesn't it?



So where do we go from there?

Well God once asked a man who was an ancient King something. Here is what was said:


1 Ki 3:5 At Gibeon the LORD appeared to Solomon during the night in a dream, and God said, "Ask for whatever you want me to give you."

Now the reason I mention this is that Solomon wanted wisdom, a discerning heart.

God says: I will do what you have asked. I will give you a wise and discerning heart, so that there will never have been anyone like you, nor will there ever be.

Solomon had a book of the bible written about how to gain wisdom. . .

... it is **proverbs!**



About the middle of the book!

Proverbs 1

Purpose

- ¹ These are the proverbs of Solomon. He was the son of David and the king of Israel.
- ² Proverbs teach you wisdom and train you.

They help you understand wise sayings.

- ³ They provide you with training and help you live wisely.
 - They lead to what is right and honest and fair.
- ⁴ They give understanding to childish people.

They give knowledge and good sense to those who are young.

- ⁵ Let wise people listen and add to what they have learned.
 - Let those who understand what is right get guidance.
- ⁶ What I'm teaching also helps you understand proverbs and stories.

It helps you understand the sayings and riddles of those who are wise.

There are 31 chapters and that is interesting because there is a maximum of 31 days in a month.

So, if we want to get wisdom, perhaps reading one chapter a day, and repeating it for a year would mean we read these deep words twelve times.

During that time we will live life and be able to apply them!

Then, our life experience and God's word will work together to increase our wisdom (provided we have started out fearing God).

This is worth more than academic degrees and is freely done.

Think about it!

One last thing...

... you also need to believe it!
