The only way to make a man trustworthy is to trust him. ~Henry L. Stimson

"Trust" is an action word and "distrust" an inaction word.



Trust is a hidden gift from one person to another, it is the exposure of our lives into the domain of control of another. It demonstrates our vulnerability to that person in a personal way!


# Trust given cannot be taken back, but unfortunately it can be abused!

The pain that results from the abuse depends on how much we have revealed of ourselves in that trust, how important the trusted person is to us, and how badly they have taken the confidential special information imparted and thrown it into

public view.



When people do this, doesn't it feel like we have had our private parts exposed and our relationship made public in a way that is not right?



So to protect ourselves we can stop trusting. Unfortunately, never trusting others is equally damaging! We will fail to develop deep relationships because depth of relationship depends on intimacy, and intimacy depends on trust. To love deeply, means we must trust extensively!

### How do we do trust then?

We need to evaluate the words of others to see if their actions align with their words before we trust them. Watch to see how much alignment they get between what they tell us and what they do in relationships with others and ourselves.

Trust, view of life, and morals are close companions.

How much of what we see in others aligns with their stated view of life?

Can they even "state" their view of life?

Can we state our view of life, and why good is good, and bad is bad?

Do we have soft reasons like "because it makes me feel good", are we double minded and say "sometimes it's good and sometimes it's not", or do we take a Christian and perhaps other religions perspectives of saying what God says is good is good?



Crazy thought, but without religion there is no absolutes of right and wrong is there?

There is only a slippery slope of opinions of others that influence me!



If the crowd says we are wrong, and it's not good, then it must be right!


Do crowds get things right?


Public opinion is a poor guide to morals!

History shows that man left to his own devises screws up!


How much to agree with that statement? that statement are you of so, how much are you willing to do to make willing to do to make sure we don't screw up?

# So to have a good understanding of trust one has to turn to religion.

Being Christian, that means I turn to the bible as a sacred writing to find out about it, and I learn that God is the owner of what is right and wrong.

We can agree or disagree, but it's like a feather arguing with the wind, if we decide to disagree.

Our opinion is there, but it really is of little consequence if God is really God!



Then we read something amazing like:

1 Corinthians 4 This, then, is how you ought to regard us: as servants of Christ and as those entrusted with the mysteries God has revealed.

Now it is required that those who have been given a *trust* must prove faithful.

I care very little if I am judged by you or by any human court; indeed, I do not even judge myself.

My conscience is clear, but that does not make me innocent. It is the Lord who judges me.

Why is this amazing? Well it's amazing because the God of the universe has chosen to trust us! Unfortunately we have proven ourselves untrustworthy time and time again!

Fortunately for us God knows something important, the quote from Henry L. Stimson alludes to it. . . the only way to make a man trustworthy is to trust him.

God trusts us because he wants us to become more trustworthy.

## God trust is based on faith in us not failing Him!

His friend, this guy, Paul, who wrote these things for us, points out God having trusted us wants us to be faithful with the secret things he has entrusted to us!

He wants us to treat what he gives us with respect and not abuse it publically or even in private. He wants us to grow in strength and intimacy with himself. Have you noticed that those that are most intimate with God are also those that are most enthusiastic to do what he asks? (Sometimes they go overboard, but don't we all do that now and then?).

We need to hold God's truths honorably, but with great respect for those around us because they are not only respected but loved by God.



So, to be trustworthy, means firstly being trustworthy to God and living our lives according to his truths, and then it means showing (and not necessarily telling) others how these truths make a difference in our lives so that they know we are able to be trusted.

Then, when the trust is placed with us we should treasure these trusts and do our best to not abuse them.

That way we can improve not only our world, but our relationship with our Father God at the same time.

Now isn't that cool?
