- Gen 2:16 You are free to eat from any tree in the garden; but you must not eat from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil,
- **Pre-History:** Beginning of Mankind
- OPPORTUNITY: Live Godly life as an individual forever
- Mankind: Happily naked, No knowledge evil exists, Simple existence Live directly off the land)
- Failure PRIDE! We decide we know better than God! EVIL enters us!
- Worship: Direct contact with God
- God's response: No eternal life with EVIL (Gen 3:21)

- Gen 4:2 Now Abel kept flocks, and Cain worked the soil.
- Pre-History: Started after 13000 B.C. before 8000 B.C
- OPPORTUNITY: Live Godly family life
- Mankind: Managing livestock, Managing the land, crops, Family groups live, work and worship together.
- Failure PRIDE! We fail again! CAIN decides God is wrong! Murder! EVIL breaks families apart! Joshua 24:2,14
- God's response: Separates evil people from good (e.g. flood)
- Worship: family worship (clay figurines, mounds)

Worship in FARMING times

- Individual worship changes to family worship (clay figurines, mounds)
- Joshua 24:2 and 24:14 noted that Terah and Abraham's ancestors had worshiped idols
 - Joshua spoke to all of the people. He said, "The Lord is the God of Israel. He says, 'Long ago your people lived east of the Euphrates River. They worshiped other gods there. Your people included Terah. He was the father of Abraham and Nahor.







SAMUEL 8 When Samuel grew old, he appointed his sons as judges for Israel. The name of his firstborn was Joel and the name of his second was Abijah, and they served at Beersheba. But his sons did not walk in his ways. They turned aside after dishonest gain and accepted bribes and perverted justice. So all the elders of Israel gathered together and came to Samuel at Ramah. They said to him, "You are old, and your sons do not walk in your ways; now appoint a king to lead us, such as all the other nations have."

But when they said, "Give us a king to lead us," this displeased Samuel; so he prayed to the LORD. And the LORD told him: "Listen to all that the people are saying to you; it is not you they have rejected, but they have rejected me as their king. As they have done from the day I brought them up out of Egypt until this day, forsaking me and serving other gods, so they are doing to you. Now listen to them; but warn them solemnly and let them know what the king who will reign over them will do."

- History: Israel fall 721 BC, Fall of Jerusalem and Judah into captivity approx 586 B.C.
- OPPORTUNITY: Learn evil of about idolatry, return to the good of God

- Failure Pride! Takes a long time to repent! Some die!
- God's response: Favor with idolater King's, return to their land, re-build the temple, sustain his people.
- Worship: Hebrew : <u>"synagogues"</u>, songs, God's law Idolaters: Idols, temples, sacrifices, mans law

- Mankind: crucifies God's son
- Failure PRIDE! We want to control the Empires, Peace by FORCE, Re-built Temple is desecrated and destroyed
- God's response: Jesus, Holy Spirit!

- Mankind: Individual relationship with God is more important than the church as a whole. EVIL increases: Individualism splits the church multiple times. Superiority is ME being the owner and revealer of Gods word. Soul counting and short commitment salvations.
