


# JAMES A BROTHER OF JESUS (PAST WEEKS REVIEW)


We looked at James history as a brother of Jesus and leader in the church




We considered the 12 tribes and 10 lost tribes

we looked wisdom from God that is not IQ or schooling ...and learned that the fear[respect] of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge




We looked at Anger and Words



# HOW IMPORTANT IS FREEDOM?




**Are these statements of love?**

**"Don't put that in your mouth!"**


**"Come away from the fire!"**

# What is **FREEDOM** really?

**Is it ability to do what we want when we want without any restriction being applied by the circumstances?**



The oxford dictionary defines freedom as **“The power or right to act, speak, or think as one wants”**

**Does a child have that freedom?**  
**Not really!**

**Are they safe loved and given full opportunity to develop?**  
**Normally, Yes!**


