




What happened to the 12 tribes of Israel?

A List of Names From Shem to Abraham

Shem, Arphaxad, Shelah, Eber, Peleg, Reu, Serug, Nahor, Terah, Abram. Abram was also called Abraham.

The Family Line of Abraham

`The sons of Abraham were Isaac and Ishmael.

The Family Line of Sarah

Abraham was the father of Isaac. The sons of Isaac were Esau and Israel.

Shem was the originator of the **Semitic** peoples.

Eber may have led to the term **Hebrew** although many people think it could also have come from the term Habiru.

The <u>Habiru</u> were a group of people living as nomadic invaders in areas of the <u>Fertile Crescent</u> from Northeastern Mesopotamia and Iran to the borders of Egypt in Canaan.

Israel was Semitic and Hebrew, but actually there are also a fair number of other people who would have to be classed the same way under the actual terms (and who probably would never want to be).

Jacob(<u>Israel's</u>) sons names were used to describe the tribes that were from their offspring.

Here are the short list of names of the sons of Israel.

Reuben, Simeon, Levi, Judah, Zebulun, Issachar, Dan, Gad, Asher, Naphtali, Joseph, Benjamin.


God is not finished with the tribes.

Families fight and so did the Israelites.

Up to King Solomon's time the guys stuck together but then just afterwards in about 931 B.C. *Jeroboam* formed a northern kingdom (1 Ki 12) of two tribes called **Israel**, and *Rehoboam* a southern kingdom (2 Chron. 11:1,12-14) of the rest called **Judah**.

These got called the "houses", houses of Judah and Israel.

Sometimes the House of Israel was called the House of Joseph because that was the biggest tribe.


Then in 722 BC the House of Israel was captured by Assyria and never returned to their land.


The ten were as follows:

Cyrus the Great of Persia in 538 BCE allowed some of these captives to rebuild the city of Jerusalem and the Temple. (Ezra 1:1-4, 2 Chron 36:22-23)

The reality is that tmost of the original tribes have been assimilated worldwide. This means that there is probably DNA of these folk in most of us.

The eastern Jews are probably mostly part of the Asian and eastern community.


The western Jews went into the Roman Empire and have had a few times of dispersion. Under *Roman persecution*, then under *Hitler's* being the two best known.
