# 1 Peter 3

## Wives and Husbands

Wives, follow the lead of your husbands. Suppose some of them don't believe God's word. Then let them be won to Christ without words by seeing how their wives behave. <sup>2</sup> Let them see how pure you are. Let them see that your lives are full of respect for God.

<sup>3</sup> Braiding your hair doesn't make you beautiful. Wearing gold jewelry or fine clothes doesn't make you beautiful. <sup>4</sup> Instead, your beauty comes from inside you. It is the beauty of a gentle and quiet spirit. Beauty like that doesn't fade away. God places great value on it.

<sup>5</sup> This is how the holy women of the past used to make themselves beautiful. They put their hope in God. And they followed the lead of their own husbands.

<sup>6</sup> Sarah was like that. She obeyed Abraham. She called him her master. Do you want to be like her? Then do what is right. And don't give in to fear.

<sup>7</sup> Husbands, take good care of your wives. They are weaker than you. So treat them with respect. Honor them as those who will share with you the gracious gift of life. Then nothing will stand in the way of your prayers.

# How does it tie into these words of Paul?

<sup>22</sup> Wives, follow the lead of your husbands as you follow the Lord. <sup>23</sup> The husband is the head of the wife, just as Christ is the head of the church. The church is Christ's body. He is its Savior. <sup>24</sup> The church follows the lead of Christ. In the same way, wives should follow the lead of their husbands in everything.

<sup>25</sup> **Husbands, love your wives. Love them just as Christ loved the church.** He gave himself up for her. <sup>26</sup> He did it to make her holy. He made her clean by washing her with water and the word. <sup>27</sup> He did it to bring her to himself as a brightly shining church. He wants a church that has no stain or wrinkle or any other flaw. He wants a church that is holy and without blame.

<sup>28</sup> **In the same way, husbands should love their wives.** They should love them as they love their own bodies. Any man who loves his wife loves himself. <sup>29</sup> After all, people have never hated their own bodies. Instead, they feed and care for their bodies. And that is what Christ does for the church. <sup>30</sup> We are parts of his body.

<sup>31</sup> Scripture says, "That's why a man will leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife. The two will become one." ([Genesis 2:24](#)) <sup>32</sup> That is a deep mystery. But I'm talking about Christ and the church.

<sup>33</sup> **A husband also must love his wife. He must love her just as he loves himself.** [Ephesians 5]

# Major Women mentioned in the bible

- **EVE (Genesis 1-3) [Adam]**
  - PRIDE Pre-Jewish, mother of all homo sapiens
    - screwed up royally and hooked her hubby into it as well
- **Sarai (Genesis 12-23) [Abram]**
  - IMPATIENT Pre-Jewish, Pre-Law, beauty, overly keen to help God along, protected and blessed by God
- **Rebekka (Genesis 24) [Isaac]**
  - SNEAKY Pre-Jewish, Pre-Law, beautiful but also conniving and sneaky
- **Tamar (Genesis 38) [Judah]**
  - PERSISTENT Non-Jewish, beautiful, more faithful to God than Judah himself, forced God's will onto Judah
- **Rahab (Joshua 2 & 6) [?]**
  - PERCEPTIVE Non-Jewish, prostitute who changed to follow God and saved the Jewish spies changing history
- **Ruth (Ruth) [Boaz]**
  - FAITHFUL Non-Jewish, trusted God more than expected of her by those around her, faithful
- **Bathsheba [2Sam 11]**
  - REPENTANT Non-Jewish, beautiful, influential
- **Mary [Joseph & Holy Spirit]**
  - HUMBLE MOTHER OF GOD Jewish, pure, gentle, accepting of grandeur with humility
- **GOD CHOSSES TO USE WOMEN OF ALL PERSUASIONS TO DO HIS WORK**
  - HOW we get used depends on the amount we release our lives to GOD!
